

Walking with Jesus — 2012 Spring Daily Spiritual Practices

In 2012, let's take our faith "**outside the walls**" of churchland to impact our world for Jesus. This spring, we will look at the books of Acts and John, noticing how Jesus and his followers touched others' lives. The Heartlight Community is encouraged to do the following as part of our daily spiritual practices to help us in this focus:

- Say the *Habakkuk 3:2* prayer each day:
*LORD, I have heard of your fame;
I stand in awe of your deeds, LORD.
Repeat them in our day,
in our time make them known.*
- Use the the **ACTS** method of prayer one time each day:
 - **Adoration** (check out [Passion for Praise](#) to help with adoration)
 - **Confession** (confessing our faith & confessing our sin to God)
 - **Thanksgiving** (giving thanks for what God is doing in our lives)
 - **Supplication** (prayers for others — see our Prayer Warriors list)
- If you are looking for more, some of us are also continuing to say the following as part of our daily spiritual practices.

The Great Compass: The Lord's Prayer (*Matthew 6:9-13 NKJV*)

*Our Father in heaven,
Hallowed be Your name.
Your kingdom come.
Your will be done
On earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our debts,
As we forgive our debtors.
And do not lead us into temptation,
But deliver us from the evil one.
For Yours is the kingdom and the power
and the glory forever. Amen.*

The Great Command — "The Jesus Shema" (*Deuteronomy 6:4; Matthew 22:37-40 NIV*)

Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one! ... Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself.

The Great Commission — Last Words, First Priority (*Matthew 28:18-20 NIV*)

Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
